

**SDC/Eldridge Committee**  
**Monthly GE Forum Meeting Update: 5/7/18**

1. Brief summary of workshop response – 250 people, great feedback, document with synthesis of input is online. Summary has been forwarded to local and state officials and legislators.
2. County B/S action item on agenda for tomorrow: Board is being asked to: a) authorize funding for staff from various County departments and agencies to engage in the SDC transition planning and governance structure development; and b) Support legislation to implement recommended governance structure consistent with County interests. The staff report outlines 14 County interests that are closely aligned to the interests reflected in our committee’s goals and in the input received during the workshop. If people are interested in supporting this action, they can attend the meeting and speak. The item is on the consent agenda, but people can request to speak on the item before the Board votes.
